STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES FOR TRIPS

In order for all to enjoy this trip and make it possible for us to continue to have this type of activity, we need to be reminded of certain responsibilities. We will behave as ladies and gentlemen at all times and will respect the authority invested in our chaperons, bus drivers and staff members.

1. The following school rules, District Discipline Code, and the Activity/Athletic Code regulations will apply at all times on a school trip. For your information, safety and well-being:
 - a. No use or possession of alcoholic beverage.
 - b. No use or possession of tobacco in any form.
 - c. No use, possession, sale, or distribution of any drug or narcotics.
 - d. No involvement in an offense classified as a felony or misdemeanor.
 - e. No conduct that results or is likely to result in bodily injury or damage to person or real property.

Failure on your part to follow the above regulations will result in school disciplinary action.

2. **Bus Conduct:** Do not put anything or any part of your body outside the bus, do not attract attention by yelling or signaling outside the bus. There will be no loud yelling, horseplay, throwing, or gambling.
3. **Free Time:**
 - a. Never go alone: For safety's sake, stay in groups of at least two or more students.
 - b. For your own protection, do not accept rides from anyone and do not leave the vicinity without individually checking with the person in charge.
4. **Timing:** You are expected to be on time for all activities during the trip.
